

BULL RUN

EVENT OBJECTIVE:

Try your hands at the stock market trading by analyzing different companies and taking the right decisions. This is an event where you get a chance to showcase your stock trading skills using virtual money but real companies.

EVENT STRUCTURE:

Round 1: Round based on the Indian Market.

Round 2: Elimination round, on the Indian market.

Round 3: International Market round.

Details for the rounds will be disclosed on the spot.

RULES:

1. This is an open-internet competition. Use of mobile phones and other electronic devices is permitted in the competition area.
2. At the start of the event you will be given 5,00,000 INR in virtual money.
3. The same virtual money will be used in the international market.
4. Participants will have to do transactions of the virtual money by selling and buying of shares.
5. Each participant will be given a sheet of paper-the 'Transaction sheet' on which the transactions are to be mentioned before entering the transaction floor. It is mandatory to fill the 'Transaction sheet'. The transactions cannot be altered after entering the transaction floor.
6. Organizers reserve the right to prohibit a participant from participating in the event.
7. Participants must carry a valid college ID and the registration receipt to the event.
8. In case of any dispute, the decision of the judges and organizers will be considered final and binding to all.
9. Rules may be changed without prior intimation. Participants are requested to check the MindSpark'16 website (www.mind-spark.org) regularly for updates.
10. All undergraduate and postgraduate students are allowed to participate.

TEAM AND FEE STRUCTURE:

Team Size : 1 participant per team.
Registration fee : ₹50/- per team.

FAQs:

Q. What is Bull Run?

A. Bull Run is basically a virtual stock market and like a stock market, the participant may buy/sell shares and invest in the stock market.

Q. Who can participate in this event?

A. Anyone who is keen on testing their market skills or is interested in playing with shares or just wants to experience the stock market environment can participate in this event.

Q. Should I have complete knowledge of the stock market for participating?

A. Not at all. You only need to interpret the given news logically and be confident, alert and quick in making decisions.

Q. How should I decide to buy or sell the shares?

A. You just have to interpret the flashing news very logically and relate it with its effect on the costs of shares. Also, you have to interpret the relative effect of one share on other.

Q. How do I buy or sell the shares?

A. A transaction sheet will be provided to you at the start of the round. News would be projected on a large screen outside the transaction floor. You have to fill the 'Transaction Sheet' depending upon the news. The sheet will then be stamped by the coordinator. Then you need to submit the sheet to the volunteer who would be handling your transactions on a computer on the Bull Run software. After this, you need to check the transactions on screen of the software. Only after ensuring with you that the transactions made in the software are as per those mentioned on the sheet, the volunteer would feed the data to the software.

Q. What if my 'Transaction sheet' gets lost?

A. You have to take utmost care of the 'Transaction sheet'. If lost, it will lead to your disqualification.

Q. What if my bought shares' total cost exceeds the assigned budget?

A. In case of such an occurrence, the participant shall be disqualified in that round itself and wouldn't be allowed to play any further rounds. So utmost care should to be taken so that the total money of the invested shares doesn't exceed the given limit.
