EVENT OBJECTIVE:

It is important to balance what you are learning in the classroom to actually applying all those theoretical concepts. This is what Epitome is all about! “Epitome” is a model making competition. Your ability to make a structure of the highest quality from the given materials in given constraints is tested. Prove your mind’s spark through your innovative, safe and cost conscious design and technique and you shall be conferred with the title of Epitome (the greatest)

EVENT STRUCTURE:

Round 1: Multiple choice questions.

Round 2: The qualified teams have to make a structure for the problem statement within the given time using the materials provided by the organizers.

TEAM SIZE AND FEES STRUCTURE:

Team size : Maximum 3 participants per team.
Registration Fee : ₹150/- per team.

RULES:

1. All team members must come with valid college ID cards and registration receipt. Participants may not be allowed to participate in the event if they fail to present the IDs and receipt.
2. All team members should reach the event venue on time. Tardiness may be considered as grounds for disqualification.
3. The team has to construct the model from provided material only. No extra material will be provided. The team should use only that material which is provided by the organizers. If the material used is other than that provided, then the team will be disqualified immediately.
4. Using materials of other participants is also strictly prohibited i.e. using some extra materials.
5. One team can make only one model for proposed competition.
6. Testing of models will be done according to the serial number given to the particular team at the time of commencement of the event. Hence no team should request for their model to be tested first.
7. The decision of the judges and the organizers will be final and binding to all.

8. Team members may be from different colleges. However, same person cannot be a part of multiple teams for the same event.

9. All teams must maintain decorum at all times. Organizers may disqualify any team that behaves inappropriately.

10. Rules may be changed without prior intimation. Participants are, therefore, requested to check the official MindSpark'16 website (www.mind-spark.org) regularly for updates.

FAQs:

Q. Do we need to bring anything with us on the day of the event?

A. Everything required for the event will be provided by the organizers. Participants need to get valid college ID cards and registration receipt.

Q. Are participants allowed to use their own materials to make the model?

A. No. The participants must use only the materials provided by the organizers.

Q. Is a team of students from different colleges allowed?

A. Yes. Team members may be from any year, any branch and any college with a valid college ID card. But one participant may not be a part of more than one teams for the same event.

Q. Can I participate in other events of MindSpark?

A. Yes, you are free to participate in as many events as you want. However you have to manage your own schedule.

Q. What if the problem is so tough that hardly anyone is able to get through, will everyone be disqualified?

A. Basically this event comprises of on-the-spot problem statement, so care will be taken that it will be suitable as per the time allotted for its completion. And if in case, everyone fails to complete the task, features of the structure/model attempted and the associated degree of completion will be taken into consideration while giving judgement.

Q. Will on spot registrations take place?

A. Yes. You may register on the spot.
