EVENT STRUCTURE:

Round 1: Submission of abstract giving a general idea about the project. Students have to choose from the broad topics which will be given on the website (www.mind-spark.org) and submit a specific abstract stating a problem and the solution to it.

Last Date of Submission: 15th September 2016

Round 2: The shortlisted students will have to give a demonstration and explanation of the project in front of a jury. A time limit (and buffer) will be given followed by a Q&A session with the Jury.

Round 3: The last round will be a Group Discussion Round, the details of which will be disclosed on the spot.

RULES:

1. The event is open for all students.

2. All the participants should have valid ID card of their respective institute with them, along with the registration receipt.

3. Abstract submitted in Round 1 should be in not more than 300 words. The abstract should be submitted in a .pdf format only. The abstract must contain:

- a. Names of all team members
- b. Name of the College and branch
- c. Contact details of all the team members

The abstracts should be sent to the following Email ID: greenspectrum@mind-spark.org

4. Innovative ideas and the problem solving approach will be entertained, copy-pasted stuff will not be considered.

5. Participants have to present their ideas in no more than 10 (7+3) minutes.

6. The decision of judges and event heads will be final and binding to all.

7. In case any assistance is needed during the event, the teams should approach only the organizers of the event.

8. People from different institutions can be a part of the same team. However, one person cannot be a part of multiple teams for same event.

9. Participants are expected to be on time. Teams coming late may be disqualified.

10. Rules may be changed without prior intimation. Participants are requested to check the MindSpark'16 website (www.mind-spark.org) regularly for updates.

TEAM AND FEE STRUCTURE:

Team Size : Maximum 2 participants per team.

Registration Fees : ₹50/- per team.

FAQs:

Q. I have an interdisciplinary/ intercollegiate group. Will it do?

A. Yes, you or your group can be interdisciplinary/ intercollegiate, but a student can't be part of two groups.

Q. I have participated in other events of MindSpark, so can I apply?

A. You are allowed to take part in any other event/s of MindSpark, provided you manage your event timings.

Q. Who can participate in this event?

A. Any undergraduate and postgraduate student from any branch or a non-engineering course can participate in this event.

Q. Can I choose my own topic?

A. Yes, you can choose your own topic, as long as it is related to the theme.
