EVENT OBJECTIVE:

This event tests your ability to make use of every resource available in an optimized manner under time constraint. It gives you a chance to explore yourself and bring out a creative and innovative spark to create something from junk i.e. '**Jugaad from Kabaad**'. Brainstorming, innovation and fun with junk, MECHTRIX has it all. So put on your hat of creativity, get ready to dirty your hands and let the 'Junkyard War' begin.

EVENT STRUCTURE:

Round 1: MCQ round (no elimination).

Rounds 2&3: Complete the given task using the materials provided by the organizers.

There will be elimination after the second round based on the combined points of 1st and 2nd rounds and the shortlisted teams will compete in the final round for the title of the **MECHTRIX CHAMPIONS**.

RULES:

1. No external equipment other than that provided by the organizers can be used.
2. Using equipment of other participants is also strictly prohibited (i.e. using some extra material).
3. The registered teams will have to carry their registration receipt and college ID cards at the time of the event.
4. Participants can be of different colleges/institutions. But, one person may not be a part of multiple teams for the same event.
5. The teams must adhere to the spirit of healthy competition.
6. Organizers reserve the right to disqualify any team indulging in misbehavior or violating any rules.
7. In case of disputes, the decision of the organizers and the judges will be final and binding to all.
8. Any team that is not ready at the specified time will be disqualified from the competition automatically.
9. Rules may be changed without prior intimation. Participants are requested to check the website (www.mind-spark.org) regularly for updates.

TEAM AND FEE STRUCTURE:

Team Size : Maximum 4 participants per team.
Registration fee : ₹150/- per team.

FAQs:

Q. Is it necessary to be an engineering student/a mechanical engineering student?

A. No, it most certainly is not. Any undergraduate student (from same or different educational institutes) can participate in the event.

Q. What preparation do I need to participate in the event?

A. No preparation is needed. But presence of mind is highly expected.

Q. Can a team comprise of members from different colleges and years?

A. Yes, there are no such restrictions. However, no participant can be part of two teams.

Q. Do I need to bring anything with me on the day of the event?

A. Everything from the tools to the junk required for the event will be provided on the spot. Only registration receipts and college ID cards will do.

Q. What if the problem is so tough that hardly anyone is able to get through, will you disqualify everyone?

A. Basically, this event comprises of on-the-spot problem statement, so we will take care that they will be suitable as per the time allotted for its completion. And if in case, everyone fails to complete the task, teams moving to the next round will be picked based on the functionality and features of structure/model attempted and the associated degree of completion.

Q. Is it possible to participate in other events of MindSpark?

A. You are free to participate in as many events as you want. However, you have to manage your own schedule.
